## Office Memorandum

Subject: Constitution of National Working Group for Community System Strengthening (CSS) and Community Led Monitoring under NACP.

As you are aware, communities are at the forefront of the NACP and moving forward with new phase of NACP, NACO envisions a stronger community engagement, involvement and community ownership at all levels of the programme.

Against this backdrop, a National Stakeholder Consultation on Community Systems Strengthening (CSS) was organised on 18th February 2021, with active involvement of Community members, civil society representatives, programme experts, and other development partners, bilateral agencies officials of SACS, NACO & TSUs. The report of the consultation is enclosed.

In accordance to the recommendations, NACO asked UNAIDS to seek nominations from civil societies and community networks to set up a National Working Group to guide and oversee the implementation of CSS in India as well as recommend to NACO the final draft of Implementing Framework, Standard Operating Procedures, for NACO to adopt as national guidelines as well as monitor and provide inputs on the implementation CSS and Community Led Monitoring (CLM). The term of reference (TOR) for the CSS National Working Group is enclosed.
